Community Use Agreement Panel meeting was held last week they had received four applications for use three were accepted one applicant was asked for further information before decision was made Next meeting is 9th April Jon to keep group up to date with this. Members were asked if any clubs wished to apply

Adam Waldron has received his payment from the talented athletes fund.

Ian went to a meeting regarding the Peel Moat site a letter is to go out next week asking for interest this will be sent to local community/sports clubs there will be a small ad in the paper and on council website. This is for full size artificial turf pitch community building with changing rooms

Woodley Sports are selling space to put up advertising, It was asked if we would be able to put banners up at Woodley to promote Sports Stockport Ian will ask the cost involved in this.

We have 183 clubs registered on Sports Stockport website 48 of these clubs have paid the affiliation fee.

Norbury Lacrosse Club applied for funding from the Club Development Fund this was to help increase the junior section it will be used to purchase equipment pay for coaching and referee courses and for CRB checks the total cost was £5942.50 the club have received some funding from the NGB and are raising money by bag packing Full award of £300 paid.

Juno United FC applied for funding from the Club Development Fund this was to set up an under 8s team it will be used to fund kit and facilities overall cost is £640.00 Full award of £300.00 paid.

Elliot Young (Cricket) applied for help from the Talented Athlete Fund he [plays for Hawk Green CC and has been selected to be part of Cheshire Cricket Academy and centre of excellence which is based in Crewe the estimated cost for 2012 was around £1900.00 for equipment travel and coaching costs Application was backed by Cheshire Cricket Board Full award £250.00 awarded.

Get Coaching awards to date this year are £4307.50

Club Development awards to date this year are £3000.00.

Playing Pitch Strategy is being drawn up by KKP they have started work on this document and have been commissioned by SMBC this will cover all marked outdoor playing pitches Ian to ask why questionnaires differ depending on the sport being played A copy of the letter to be sent to all clubs on Website. This report is due to be published by the end of May. It was suggested we invite someone to come to either the AFM or a meeting to discuss the findings of the report.
